### Next Week – Theatre Week

- All children will need to bring a cut lunch (there are no facilities for heat ups) and a bottle of water (it's hot work under the stage lighting).
- All children will come in their school uniform, their costumes will be at the theatre waiting for them.
- Girls are asked to have their hair in a tidy ponytail or bun – it's important we can see your lovely faces.
- Unfortunately, due to Covid restrictions, we are unable to have parents join us in the theatre at any time. If you have to pick your child up for an appointment or you would like to drop them off late, please let Di at the office know the time etc and someone can meet you out the front of the theatre on Irk Street.
- We will follow the health and safety regulations of the St James Theatre, the children will be inducted on Monday morning.
- Wednesday – if possible, please send your child to school with foundation makeup on their face. We will put the rest of their makeup on at the theatre. If you don't have foundation makeup, we will have some spare so don't rush out and buy some.
- As you will have seen in the newsletter, there will no longer be any live shows on the night of Wednesday 3rd or Thursday 4th November.

Parents and whānau, thank you for your support throughout the last two terms and for being understanding that we are unable to have you as a live audience - it's a real bummer! But we have plans to make it up to you, there's more to come... and it's really exciting.
